

2023 – 2024 Class FAQ's

- How do I register?
 - o The registration process includes the completion of our registration form and payment of the initial yearly, per household registration fee \$25 and the quarter's tuition. Class spots cannot be held for a student until the registration process has been completed and all the initial fees have been paid. If you would like to return for another quarter, please visit your student account at thewallis.org/education.
- How do I request a scholarship?
 - o The Wallis is offering a limited amount of scholarships to students for the 2023-2024 school year (September 1, 2023 through August 31, 2024) based on a combination of financial need, interest in the arts, and/ or demonstrated musical or artistic skills.
- How do I pay & what are they payment terms?
 - o Tuition for classes is charged on a "per 8 week quarter" basis. Each class is held once per week. Tuition is charged to each student's account on the day of the registration. The full quarter tuition amount must be paid in full whether or not all classes are attended. We offer the following payment options for your convenience:
 - Pay in person by check or credit card (Amex, Visa, MasterCard and Discover) during our office hours.
 - Pay over the phone (we will email your receipt).
 - Pay online from the comfort of your own home via the emailed invoice or by logging in to your student portal at www.thewallis.org/education
- What happens if I can't make a class?
 - No refunds or credits are issued for student absences, whether it is due to illness, vacation, or other reasons. If a class is cancelled due to an instructor absence or other reason, a credit will be issued to the student's account for the value of the lesson.
 - o No refunds will be issued. No make-up classes are provided in cases of either student or teacher absence.

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
