(Beverly Hills, CA, January 30, 2019) A staged reading of *CHOICE* written and directed by Tony Award nominee and Drama Desk Award-winner Winnie Holzman (*Wicked*, "My So-Called Life"), starring Allison Janney (*I, Tonya*, "Mom"), Tony Shalhoub ("The Marvelous Mrs. Maisel," "Monk"), Bess Armstrong (*The Four Seasons, High Road to China*), Paul Dooley (*Sixteen Candles*, "Curb Your Enthusiasm"), Madeline Wise (HBO's "Crashing") and Raviv Ullman ("Phil of the Future," "Rita Rocks") will be performed at the Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts on Saturday, February 29, 2020, at 7:30 pm in The Wallis' Bram Goldsmith Theater, in collaboration with Hayloft Productions. *CHOICE*, which explores a woman's right to choose in decidedly unexpected ways, is the timely and topical story of what happens when a respected journalist finds herself at the epicenter of a controversial social phenomenon. As she re-examines her past and discovers a new way of looking at the future, her family, her closest friendship and her entire belief system will never be the same. It is Holzman's first work for the stage since her collaboration with Stephen Schwartz for the smash hit musical *Wicked*, for which she wrote the book. An earlier version of *Choice* was performed in 2015 by Boston's Huntington Theatre Company. A portion of the proceeds from the staged reading will benefit the Center for Reproductive Rights.

"CHOICE is a passion project, and it's unlike anything I've ever written," says playwright Winnie Holzman, "I'm truly thrilled to have this opportunity to present a play that means so much to me at The Wallis."

"As a part of our commitment to develop and produce new work, we are very excited and honored to provide a platform for Winnie's important and timely story," stated The Wallis' Artistic Director Paul Crewes.

About the Artists:

Winnie Holzman (Playwright/Director) is the writer (with composer/lyricist Stephen Schwartz) of the hit musical Wicked. She got her start writing for the groundbreaking TV drama "thirtysomething," and went on to create another memorable series - "My So-Called Life" starring Claire Danes. She later executive produced (again with her mentors Marshall Herskovitz and Edward Zwick) the series "Once and Again" and (with her daughter, Savannah Dooley) the ABC Family Series "Huge." Most recently, she collaborated with Cameron Crowe and J.J. Abrams on the Showtime series "Roadies." She's collaborated with her husband Paul Dooley on two plays -- Post-its: Notes on a Marriage, and Assisted Living. Sometimes recognized as the chocolate-obsessed woman in the beloved movie Jerry Maguire and as Larry David's wife's therapist on "Curb Your Enthusiasm," Holzman is a graduate of Princeton University, and holds an MFA from the NYU Musical Theatre Program.
