The two comedians will come together on the stage of the Bram Goldsmith Theater for an intimate discussion about Franken's new book *Giant of the Senate*.

Al Franken used to be a comedian, our nation's foremost political satirist. Then he decided to run for office. His new book, *Giant of the Senate*, takes us deep into his unlikely campaign and into its more improbable ending—the closest Senate election outcome in history and an unprecedented eight month recount saga. Only Al Franken, a true “Giant of the Senate” could make that funny.

So what happens when an award-winning comedian with an army of loyal fans from “Saturday Night Live” and progressive radio, gets a chance to serve in the Senate? Senator Franken defies the low expectations from pundits and turns out to be good at it. *Giant of the Senate* is about our deeply polarized, frequently depressing and sometimes inspiring political culture. This candid memoir covers family, marriage, comedy and some of his most dramatic—and hilarious—moments in politics.

Marc Maron is the creator and host of the popular podcast, *WTF with Marc Maron*, in which he interviews comedians, celebrities and persons of interest—including former President Obama. Maron is a stand-up comedian, an author and the star of the television comedy series on IFC, *Maron*. He can be seen in the Netflix series *Glow* this summer.
